



## *The Society of London Lady Golf Captains*

### *Rules*

**1. DESIGNATION**

The Society shall be called the “SOCIETY OF LONDON LADY GOLF CAPTAINS”

**2. MEMBERSHIP**

Captains and ex-captains of recognised Golf Clubs situated not more than 30 miles from Charing Cross shall be eligible for membership.

**3. SUBSCRIPTION**

The entrance fee and subscription for playing, annual or non-playing life membership shall be such as decided by the Committee and ratified at the Annual General Meeting.

Subscriptions are due in advance on the first of October in each year.

Any member whose subscription is in arrears by the first of May in any one year shall cease to be a member of the society, but may be reinstated at the discretion of the Committee.

No member in arrears may compete in any competition or vote at any meetings.

Any member wishing to withdraw from the Society shall give notice in writing to the Honorary Secretary on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September in any year, otherwise she shall be liable to pay her subscription for the following year.

**4. MANAGEMENT**

The management of the Society shall be in the hands of a Committee consisting of the Captain, who shall be Chairman of the Committee, the President, the Vice-Captain, the Immediate Past Captain, the Honorary Secretary, the Honorary Treasurer and up to 10 elected members. Six members shall form a quorum. The Committee shall have the power to co-opt two members to serve on Committee.

**5. ELECTION OF PRESIDENT**

The President shall be nominated by the Committee, and her election confirmed at the Annual General Meeting. She shall be elected for a period of one year.



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**6. ELECTION OF CAPTAIN AND VICE-CAPTAIN**

The Captain and Vice-Captain, who shall have served on the Committee, shall be nominated by the Committee, and their election confirmed at the Annual General Meeting. Their term of office shall be one year.

**7. ELECTION OF HONORARY SECRETARY AND HONORARY TREASURER**

The Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer shall be nominated by the Committee and their election confirmed at the Annual General Meeting. Their term of office shall not exceed five years.

**8. ELECTION OF MEMBERS FOR THE COMMITTEE**

Any two members of the Society may nominate a full member of the Society to serve on the Committee, having previously received the assent of the full member, and bearing in mind County representation. The name of each member so nominated shall be submitted in writing, duly proposed and seconded, to the Honorary Secretary, at least twenty one days before the Annual General Meeting. The Members of the Committee shall be elected for three years, after which they must retire and shall not be eligible for re-election for one year.

**9. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

An Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than the first week in December each year for the following purposes:

- a) To receive the Captain's Report
- b) To receive the Statement of Accounts
- c) To elect the Officers and Members of the Committee
- d) To consider resolutions and any other business

**10. RULES**

Rules shall not be rescinded or altered unless passed at a General Meeting.  
The Committee shall be the sole authority for the interpretation of these Rules.
